Priscilla's main areas of practice are corporate, civil and employment law. She heads the Financial Institution Practice Group for the Africa region of Dentons. Over the years, she has been involved in a number of M&As and IPOs, many of them involving companies in the global business sector or foreign companies investing in Mauritius, on the African continent or India. Priscilla advises and acts on behalf of banks, private equity, Investment Funds as well as private clients. She has a keen interest in Fintech and ESG (Environment, Social and Governance) matters.

Furthermore, Priscilla is very familiar with both the private and the public sector in Mauritius, having worked with both of them.
